Topics to be presented include “Fescue Seed Production & Feeding Aftermath” by Dave Danker, Buchheit’s Agri-Division Manager; “Use of Co-Products in Livestock Nutrition” by Ben Davis, University Outreach & Extension Livestock Specialist; “Can we Afford to Fertilize?” by Will McClain, University Outreach & Extension

Regional Specialist; and “Year-Round Contract Grazing” by Eric & Rudy Fuch, Wayne County producers.
